All Sundays and second Saturdays have been shown in red colour. Local holidays i.e. 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> Mar; 18<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> Oct; 05<sup>th</sup> Nov will be observed exclusively by the High Court. 03<sup>st</sup> Mar & 06<sup>th</sup> Nov will be observed as Local Holidays by the High Court and the Courts Subordinate to it.

The High Court will remain closed for Summer Vacation from Monday, 04<sup>th</sup> June to Saturday, 30<sup>th</sup> June (both days inclusive) and for Winter Vacation from Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> December to Monday, 31<sup>th</sup> December (both days inclusive).
